



Standards Coverage by Curriculum Source

HOW TO: Looking at your Course Summary page, click the **Coverage** tab. Select the *Source*. Leave *Section* blank to select entire Source contents at once. Click the button to Add Resources.

In the **Resources** section on the page below the search form, you can expand individual sections to review and delete included items.

In the **Standards** section farther down, the Standard name, its associated Grade level and Priority are displayed, along with the Coverage Count. The Coverage Count column shows how many times a Standard is “covered”, either by an Instruction Strategy or an Assessment Strategy, by the selected resources.

A red “x” indicates “zero” – that the selected resources do not cover this standard at all. Print this page to help with your ongoing lesson-planning process.
