


The Selector

 **PURPOSE:** Where you add Resources – Standards, Instruction Strategies, and Assessment Strategies – to a Plan.


The page is divided into two main parts, *Search* form and *Search Results*. Each includes multiple subparts.

1. Search – includes three methods to find resources.



2. Search Results – displays a list of results, depending on search method and criteria. Each method lists Standards and available Resources differently, as detailed below.

Notice the **blue number** in blue-bordered box on far-right side with each Standard listed in search results. It indicates how many times that Standard has been added to Plans in this Course.



HOW TO: Search & Add Resources

For all search forms, after selecting search criteria click the **Find It!** button to perform search. Search results will display below the search form. The page displays 20 results per page. If results list more than 20 Standards, use the navigation of page numbers and Previous/Next at the top and bottom of the search results to view different pages.

- **By Content Area**

Searching: By default, the *Content Area* and *Grade(s)* that you selected on your Course Setup are used as your search criteria. If the system also includes a *Priority* filter, then that filter will also display and can be used to filter by Priority type.

Results: Listed by Standard

Adding: Click a Standard name to expand it and view the lists of *Instruction Strategies* and *Assessment Strategies* aligned to that Standard. To add a strategy to the Plan, click  once. This icon will change to .


- **By Curriculum Source**

Searching: Use *Source* filter to choose the associated school-approved curriculum materials, such as textbooks. Use the *Section* filter to narrow your search to one chapter or unit within that source.

Results: Listed by Standard

NOTE: Only certain sources have been aligned to Standards. Those are included here.



Adding: Click button (sample at right) just below [Find It!](#) This will automatically add all of the Standards & Strategies correlated to the Source.



- **By Resource**

Searching: By default, resources listed are the ones input into your personal “bank” and associated with the *Grade(s)* for this Course.

Results: Listed by Resource name. The categories for which the resource can be applied – Instruction, Assessment, and Management – is indicated by one or more letters in the I-A-M boxes to the left of the Resource’s name displaying as **bold green**.

Adding: Click a Standard name to expand it and view the lists of *Instruction Strategies* and *Assessment Strategies* aligned to that Standard. To add a strategy to the Plan, click  once. This icon will change to .
